



Bullitt County Arts Council Scholarship Application

Eligibility requirements:

1. You must be a graduating senior and will attend a 2 or 4 year college, where you will be majoring or minoring in an arts degree program.
2. A 2.0 GPA out of a possible 4.0 from a Bullitt County High School. Documents and school transcripts that prove you are a resident of Bullitt County if you attend an official private high school or are home schooled.
3. Photo or digital images or recordings of your work may be submitted. All work must be verified that it is the work of the student. Visual art will have 5 samples. Performing arts must be 10-15 minutes in length and show a range of ability. The work may consist of one or several samples. Scores of music or scripts of performances must be included.
4. Two (2) letters of reference, including one from a high school teacher in the arts or an arts related field, are required.
5. A 300-500 word essay describing you, your educational career goals and any present and/or future community involvement in Bullitt County.
6. Completed application form. Any incomplete application will be disqualified.
7. If you have been accepted to a college, please include a copy of your acceptance letter. If you have not been accepted yet, submit the name of colleges to which you have applied and expect to be accepted (2 year or 4 year).

The BCAC Scholarship Committee reserves the right to request further information including an expanded portfolio of work, before making a final decision.

The BCAC will retain all art submissions by applicants. We reserve the right to include the applicant's works in an album of submissions which will be open to the public. We may also use submissions on the BCAC web site and for future scholarship information. The name of the artist can remain anonymous by request.

The scholarship recipients may be asked to display or perform at BCAC functions.

Selection process:

The names of the applicants will not be disclosed to the selecting committee, but will be identified by an assigned number only. Please cover names on your art work whenever possible. No committee member may be related to any applicant nor may any members be acquainted with any applicant in more than a casual manner.

Upon reviewing all applications, works of art and essays, the committee may ask questions on application materials. The application will be assigned points in the following areas:

- scholarship/merit
- community involvement
- craftsmanship
- originality
- need

The applicants and their submissions will be reviewed by the entire committee and the committee may freely discuss each application material and decide if any future application materials are needed.

Each applicant will be notified that their material have been received. They will also be notified when the scholarship winner(s) have been selected.
